HOW TO BOOK

Pre-booking is essential for any of these options. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Our maximum group size for all dining options is 40 people. Larger groups will be split across multiple time slots, with an itinerary agreed at the point of booking.

Please note that during our theatre season we will have limited availability in The Swan bar, so some dining options may not be available between 1.00pm and 2.30pm. Please bear this in mind when enquiring about bookings between April and October. Pre-Theatre Dining is available Monday to Friday between 12.00pm and 3.00pm and 5.00pm and 6.00pm.
