



About the music and insturments:

The music in Hakawatis is played on traditional Arabic instruments including **Oud** (leading the songs with a deep warm sound), **Violin** (building and easing tension) **Darbuka** (providing sharp blasts that make the songs and melodies dance through the dialogue of the show) and percussion including the low brooding **Tar** (or Duff) and the high pitched **Riq** (Tambourine) with sharp symbols that colour the compositions and drive the drama of the stories.
