GLOBE DOGS ADVENTURE TO BIGGEST WEST END SHOWS TO CELEBRATE WORLD THEATRE DAY



In **celebration of World Theatre Day** (Wednesday 27 March) a team of dogs from Shakespeare's Globe clipped on their ruffs and went on an adventure to some of London's most iconic theatres. The dogs in the tour are Bella the Red Setter, Betty the 4-month-old Border Terrier, and Heidi the Toy Poodle, each owned by Globe staff.

Theatreland lapped up these pretty pooches on their journey from Hogwarts, to Frozen's Arendelle and the backstage savannah of The Lion King, trying their paw at stand-up (sitdown?) at Soho Theatre to dancing on the Sadler's Wells stage.

Heidi, Bella, and Betty have brought 18.1million people to the Globe's Instagram since January. This playful and joyful content has been featured on ITV News London and the London Evening Standard, continues to bring audiences to the Globe social accounts. Overall, 38.1 million people have seen our content across Globe social platforms this year. Our TikTok has had 4.5 million views, and Instagram as 11.1 million views. The numbers continue to grow.

Members of the public squealed with delight at our ruffed-up dogs as they ran across London catching their favourite shows and meeting some other theatre dogs along the way!

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Shakespeare's Globe strives to make Shakespeare accessible for all. It is a registered charity and has operated independently since opening in 1997.

Shakespeare's Globe is a world-renowned theatre, education centre, and cultural landmark on the bank of the River Thames in London, UK. Founded by the pioneering American actor and director Sam Wanamaker, our site is home to two venues – the iconic open-air Globe Theatre (1997) and the candlelit indoor Sam Wanamaker Playhouse (2014).

Many of our productions also enjoy an extended life online through our video-on-demand service <u>Globe Player</u>, in cinemas across the UK, and on television. We are also a major venue for visiting artists, comedy, concerts and special events, and over our twenty-five-year history have produced over 43 world premieres of new plays, several of which have gone on to enjoy success in the West End, on Broadway and beyond.

Our Education department has long been one of the most active in the UK. We offer a hugely diverse programme of workshops, public events, university courses, and community projects. Our Guided Tour is award-winning, and our visitors also enjoy our on-site and online shop.

The Globe Theatre is a unique full-scale replica of Shakespeare's original 1599 Elizabethan open-air theatre. Our indoor candle-lit Sam Wanamaker Playhouse is an archetype of an indoor Jacobean theatre.
